On October 26, 2007, this matter was referred to the undersigned for resolution of Plaintiff’s Motion for Preliminary Injunction and Order to Shorten Time.

On October 25, 2007, Plaintiff filed a Motion to Shorten Time to Hear Plaintiff’s Motion for Preliminary Injunction (the “Motion to Shorten Time”), and Motion for Preliminary Injunction Ordering Return or Destruction of Sensitive Materials (the “Preliminary Injunction”).
