ORDER

This matter comes before the Court upon the motion filed by Marie S. Johnston and the law firm of Crowe & Dunlevy for leave to withdraw as attorneys of record for the defendant International Webworks.com, LLC ("International Webworks). Said motion states that International Webworks has requested that Crowe & Dunlevy cease its representation at this time. Therefore, the Court:

- (1) GRANTS the motion to withdraw filed on March 28, 2007;
- (2) PERMITS attorneys Marie S. Johnston and the law firm of Crowe & Dunlevy to withdraw as counsel of record for the defendant, International Webworks, subject to the condition

that all subsequent papers and pleadings shall continue to be served upon Marie S. Johnston for forwarding purposes to International Webworks until it appears by other counsel;

(3) DIRECTS International Webworks to retain counsel and to have said counsel sign and file an entry of appearance in this case on the form prescribed by the Clerk of this Court prior to April 4, 2007;

(4) ADVISES International Webworks that pursuant to LCvR17.1 and applicable Tenth Circuit authorities, it will be unable to participate in the scheduling conference set for this matter on April 4, 2007 absent an entry of appearance by counsel prior to that date. International Webworks' failure to comply with this order may result in sanctions pursuant to Rule 11 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
